Youth Bowling Results

Greater Sacramento Area USBC (GSA) Youth bowlers have earned on average **\$2,000** in scholarship funds this season from each GSA sponsored tournament.

The Adult/Junior Tournament held at Woodhaven Lanes on November 29th & 30th of 2009 seemed to be a foreshadowing of things to come. Randy Kinzler Jr teamed with dad Randy Kinzler Sr to tie for first with Caleb Nakata and Anthony Morrison team in the Scratch Division. Finishing just 15 pins behind was the team of Samantha Lawton and Dave Seiler.

Thomas Olds and Julie Kawaye earned first place scholarship monies in the B

Division with a 20 pin margin over the second place team of Marcus Harris and Anita Harris.

The C Division champion was the duo of Sabrina Bennett and Robert Denison, who eked out a 2 pin victory over brother Robert Bennett and partner Michael Rhoades.

Next up was the King/Queen & Prince/Princess tourney held at Crestview Lanes on January 24, 2010. This tournament was marked by impressive bowling at every level. Randy Kinzler Jr averaged 227 in route to earning the top seed in the King A Division as 8 competitors averaged over 200 in the 4 game qualifier. He defeated Nick Duplan in the final to win the crown. Samantha Lawton averaged 223 to

earn top seed in the Queen A Division. She went on to defeat Amber Vega in the stepladder final.

John Cuddy took top seed in the King B Division while averaging 200. He defeated second seed Roldolfo Barrera in the final. Jordan Lazaro held top seed in the Queen B Division averaging a nice 198. However, Candiz Philpott upended Jordan in the stepladder to claim the crown.

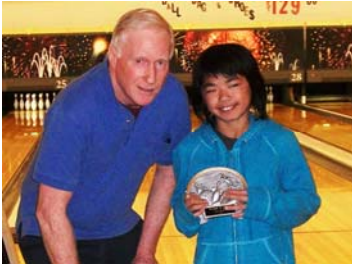
