

# *Greater Sacramento Area USBC*

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## **Nomination Form - GSA Hall of Fame**

### **PURPOSE:**

The purpose of the GSA Hall of Fame is to honor, pay tribute to, and perpetuate the names of those who have contributed to the growth and welfare of the great game of bowling by their ability and/or meritorious service in the Greater Sacramento Area USBC.

### **INSTRUCTIONS:**

1. Complete all sections of the nomination form. **PLEASE PRINT OR TYPE** information so that it is legible.
2. Include all information possible pertaining to your nominee. Be as detailed as possible (e.g. dates, places, etc.).
3. If additional space is needed to state candidate's qualifications, use additional sheets of paper.
4. Include copies of all substantiating documentation you may have.
5. Please submit a 4" X 5" close up photo of candidate with application if possible. It will be used in publicity write-ups and for the permanent honor roll if candidate is elected to the Hall of Fame.
6. Be certain to include your name, address and phone number. You may be contacted for additional information or clarification.
7. Nominations to be considered for the year must be postmarked or received by **MIDNIGHT MARCH 31**

## **NOMINATIONS**

Nominations of candidates for election to the Hall of Fame can be made by any member of the Greater Sacramento Area USBC with the following stipulations.

(a) Nominations should be submitted to the GSA Association on or before April 1st. Any received thereafter will be acted upon the following year.

(b) All nominations must indicate the category, Meritorious Service or Superior Performance, the candidate is being nominated for.

(c) All qualifications and achievements supporting the nomination of the candidate just accompany the nomination.

## **QUALIFICATIONS**

Qualifications hereafter cited shall apply to living and deceased candidates in one of two categories - Meritorious Service and Performance.

### 1. Meritorious Service

a. Ten years as an ABC, WIBC, or USBC member within the jurisdiction of GSA Bowling Association.

b. Participation, past or present, in sanctioned bowling.

c. Outstanding service in the promotion of bowling.

d. Service to bowlers leadership on a local level.

### 2. Superior Performance

a. Fifteen (15) year as an ABC/WIBC/USBA sanctioned bowler of which ten (10) must be in the Sacramento associations.

## **BALLOTING**

Balloting shall be conducted by the committee when research on qualifications of candidates has been completed. Committee will meet within two weeks of April 1st deadline to review nominations for completeness and accuracy. Balloting must be completed prior to May 1st.

## **ELECTION REQUIREMENTS**

Electors may vote for only two candidates on any one ballot. To be elected a candidate must receive at least 2/3rds of votes cast. A maximum of two (2) candidates may be elected in any one year in each category. If more than one candidate receives 2/3 of votes cast, they both may, at the discretion of the committee, be elected that year. If there are more than two candidates and no candidate receives 2/3 of the votes cast on the first ballot, a second ballot shall be taken with the top 1/2 of nominees being voted on with at least two nominees on the ballot. If no nominee receives 2/3 majority, a third ballot shall be cast with on the top two vote getters on the ballot. If no nominee receives the 2/3 majority on the third ballot, it shall be declared "no election", unless an elector requests a fourth ballot. All nominees not elected the first year will be carried over as nominees the next year. If not elected the second year, they may be re-nominated following the original procedures.

### **AWARDS**

Suitable and proper awards shall be made to the candidates elected to the Hall of Fame. In case of posthumous awards, the awards shall be presented to the nearest of kin of the deceased. The awards shall be presented with fitting ceremony at either the Annual Association Installation Dinner or at a special ceremony. Every effort should be made to include those accepting posthumous awards in the ceremony. A suitable and permanent honor roll shall be created in which the names of those elected to the Hall of Fame shall be inscribed with the year elected indicated.
